

e13 DRS and Spec. Enduro

- *Please familiarize yourself with the proper set up of the e13 DRS Chain Retention System before moving on with these set up tips.*

The Specialized Enduro's unique dropped chainstay design is the concern when setting up a DRS chain retention system. The interaction of the DRS backplate and the ISCG mount is also a concern.

- It appears that the ISCG holes in the DRS backplate must be elongated with a Dremel tool to acquire proper rotation when mounting using the ISCG holes and bolts.



- Even when this is completed one will still have to trim down the inner lower wearplate to get the DRS to clear the dropped chainstay.
